Merits and Demerits between boards

Advantages of CBSE:-

There are various advantages of CBSE first we will discuss the merits the biggest advantage of this system is that near about all the main entrance exam to professional streams are based upon CBSE syllabus which gives huge benefits to CBSE students gives as the student has already studied all that topics in their school course.

The study of CBSE board is easy compared to other boards which results in test free study environment for the students. Moreover, the secondary level subjects like physics, chemistry and biology all come under science subject and also history, geography, civics and economics comes under the social studies subject which lowers the number of subject and makes study easier.

Disadvantages of CBSE :-

Now let's talk about disadvantage of this board. An average student may feel that syllabus is difficult and will have to give a subject during 6th grade where as there are ~~6~~ ~~6~~ six subjects in CBSE for the same student.

In spite of the fact that ICSE syllabus facilitates deeper understanding and better life skills and analytical skills, when it comes to pursuing further education it might become difficult due to lack of linearity in evaluating paper after an ICSE examination by a set of standards.
