A DAY VISIT AT A.T. PANDAY ANSHRAM SCHOOL

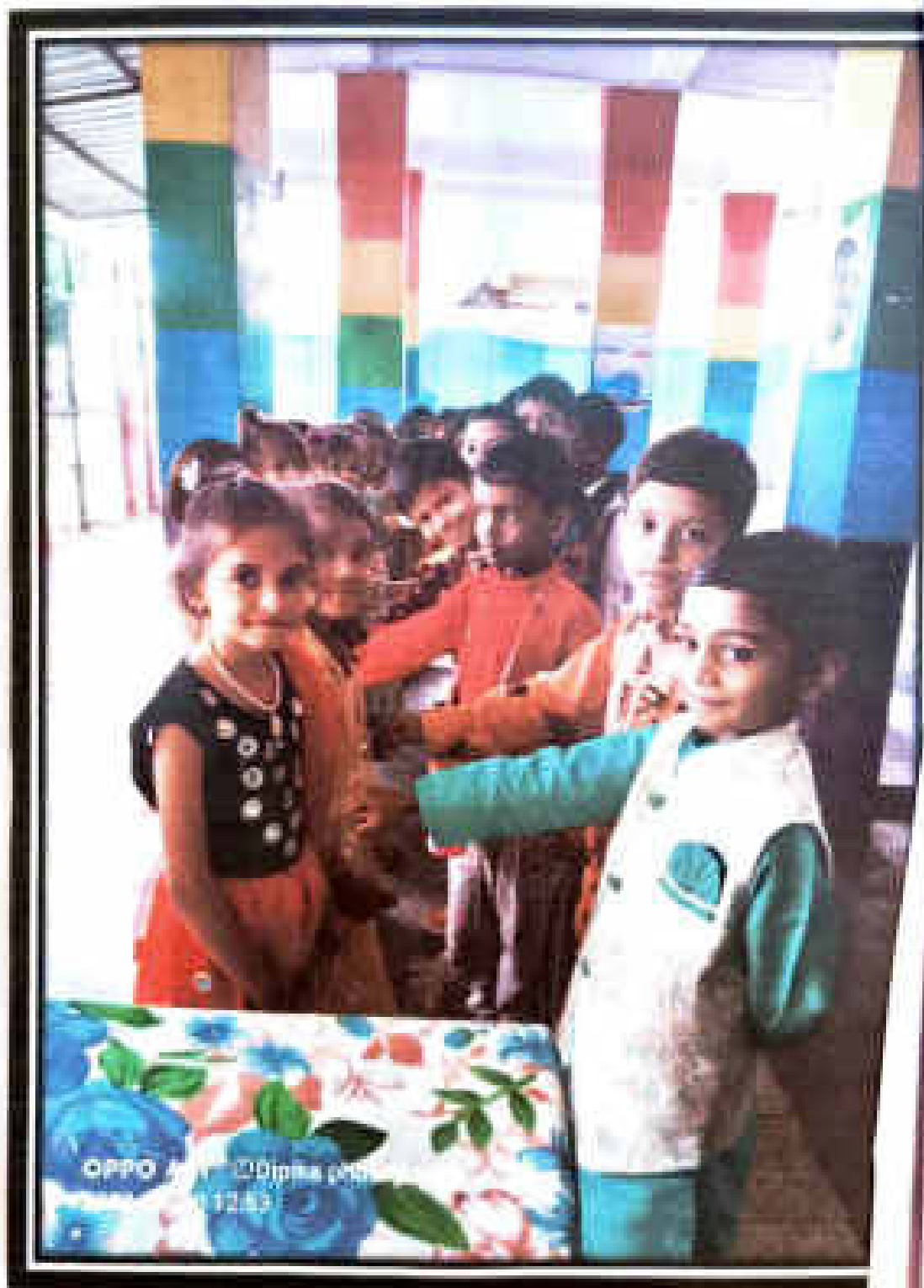

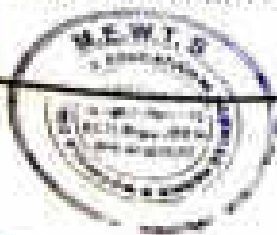
