4. Spiritual development through education in Universal Human Values.

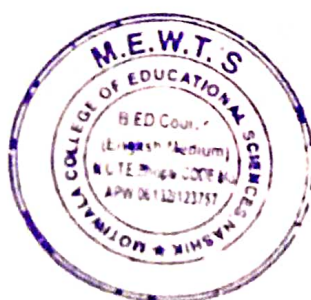



