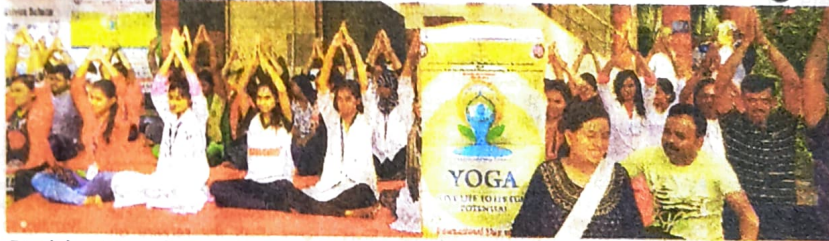

Objective:

The primary objectives of our social service activities are:

Activities Undertaken:

According to the Academic year we have conducted the following Social Service Activities:

1. Say No To Plastic Year 2018. Plastic Bags were replaced by cloth bags by our B.Ed Students.
2. Health and Hygiene for Cleanliness Workers of Nashik Ghanatagadhi Workers : 2019- Our college organized the medical camp for free health checkup and distributed hand sanitizer and firstaid box for Nashik Municipal Corporation Ghanatagadhi Labours who cleans the entire city.




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3. In 2020 due to Covid-19 Pandemic the entire process of college was online and students were doing their B.Ed course from their home. Only tree plantation was done by the students around their home.
4. Seeing Eyes Helping Hands : 2021-2022 –School Bags, Educational Equipment's such as water bottle, writing material etc were distributed in the Chirapur Addhar Ashram to the orphan Kids. Tribal Ashram School A.T. Pawar Was visited and various equipment's such as sports kits, hand wash, sanitizer, and educational equipment were distributed.
5. In 2023 the Educational equipment distribution camp was conducted by contribution of the College and our students to the nearest Z.P. School where tribal students get the education. The things like pen box, water jar, woolen sweater, nail cutter, notebooks, water bottle and so many things were distributed.

In each of our Social service Activity our Management of Motiwala College Of Educational Sciences is very supportive and motivate the staff to accomplish such society oriented activities. The managing trustee Dr.F. F. Motiwala always motivate the staff to initiate such activities and guide them to actively participate in the activity.
