WHAT IS TEACHING

- a process of interacting
- The process of engaging students in activities that will enable them to acquire the knowledge, skills, as well as worthwhile values and attitudes.

PRINCIPLES OF TEACHING

- **1.The Principle of Aim**. There should be a definite aim for every lesson.
- **2.The principle of Activity or Learning by Doing**. The child is active by nature. He has certain urges which impels him to action. He learns by doing.
- 3.Principle of Linking with Actual Life and Other Subjects. Learning should be linked with life and other subjects as far as it is convenient to do so.
- **4.The Principle of Planning.** Good teaching is always well-planned.
- 5.The Principle of Interest or Motivation. The principle of interest or motivation is the most important of all principles.

PRINCIPLES OF TEACHING

- 6. The Principle of Sympathy and Kindly Atmosphere. Good teaching cannot take place in an atmosphere which lacks kindness and sympathy.
- 7. Principle of Flexibility and Co-operation. Rigid planning is harmful for good teaching. The plan of a lesson must provide scope to make necessary changes, if need be. Teaching should be flexible to meet the unexpected situations, if any, in the classroom.
- 8. The Principle of Diagnostic and Remedial Teaching. Good teaching is diagnostic and remedial. Once the pupil's difficulties have been diagnosed, they should not be left as they are.
- 9. The Principle of Looking Ahead. Good teaching looks ahead while it also takes into account the past experiences of the children. An openminded teacher is always forward looking.
- 10. The Principle of Creativity. The idea of a good teacher is to make the pupil creative learner.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES IN THE SELECTION AND USE OF TEACHING STRATEGIES:

Learning is an active process.


We have to actively engage the learners in learning activities if we want them to learn what we intend to teach.

Research shows


- > 75% retention rates in learning by doing

The more senses that are involved in learning, the more and the better the learning.




Most learning occurs through sight, but the combination of sight and hearing accounts for about 88 percent of all perceptions.

PLANNING PHASE INCLUDES DECISION LIKE

- The needs of the learner
- The achievable goals & objectives to meet the needs
- Selection of the content to be taught
- Motivation to carry out the goal,
- Approach most fit to carry out the goals
- Evaluation process to measure learning outcome

CONSIDERATIONS IN PLANNING

- Learner
- Availability of materials
- Time requirement of particular activity
- Strategy need to achieve the objective

IMPLEMENTATION PHASE

- Based on the objective, implementation means to put into action the different activities in order to achieve the objectives through the subject matter.
- Interaction of the teacher and learner is important in the accomplishment of the plan
- Use of different teaching style and strategy are included in this phase

EVALUATION PHASE

- A match of the objective with the learning outcome will be made
- Answers the question if the plans and implementation have been successfully achieved
- Feedback

BASIC ASSUMPTIONS

- That teaching is goal oriented with the change of behaviour as the ultimate end
- That teaching is a rational and a reflective process
- That teachers by their actions can influence learners to change their own thinking or desired behaviour, thus teaching is a way of changing behaviour, through the intervention of the teacher


INTRODUCTION

- To develop critical thinking


